Novelty of PLFS 2020-21 Data: Unveiling the Post Lockdown Migration Statistics.

Puneet will present findings from his paper, 'Novelty of PLFS 2020-21 Data: Unveiling the Post Lockdown Migration Statistics'.

Abstract: The Periodic Labour Forces Survey (PLFS) of NSO, MoSPI, GoI began since 2017-18 with an objective to provide labour market (employment & unemployment situation) information on frequent basis (Annually for whole country and Quarterly for urban areas only), rather, NSSO used to give such estimates through its quinquennial rounds. The 4th series of PLFS (2020-21) seems a bit different from the last three rounds. This round has tried to fulfil the shortage of official statistics related to the Consumption Expenditure and Migration to some extent. The COVID-19 pandemic caused lockdown has adversely affected the income and livelihood of migrant workers. The schedule of PLFS 2020-21 has been modified to get information on recent labour market issues & challenges for better policy support. Prior to the release of this survey data and report, hardly any recent official data was available on the flow/ pattern of migration, migrant, reverse migrant, migrant workers & reverse migrant workers in the country. The present paper has tried to highlight some of the important statistics and inferences from this survey using the unit level records.
