## Impacts of Changing Global Economic Orders on Indian Industries

**Abstract:** The global economic order is undergoing rapid change, marked by rising protectionism, strategic industrial policies and geopolitical tensions. Major economies such as the United States, the European Union and China are increasingly adopting measures including tariffs, subsidies, local-content requirements and regulatory barriers to strengthen domestic industries and secure supply chains. These policies are reshaping global trade flows and creating both challenges and opportunities for Indian industries. In response, India has begun recalibrating its strategy through an expanded network of Free Trade Agreements (FTAs), the Production Linked Incentive (PLI) schemes to boost domestic manufacturing, and reforms aimed at improving the Ease of Doing Business (EoDB). This talk examines how these shifts in the global economic order are affecting India's industrial sectors and the policy responses needed to enhance competitiveness, resilience and integration into evolving global value chains.
